12:30-1:30 “POT LUCK” LUNCH. We will supply plenty of soup, bread, etc. So feel free to join us if you do not have anything to bring. A small donation to the soup makers is optional.

1:30-3:30 Afternoon runs

3:30-4:30 Additional runs if needed
