

LAST DITCH BUTTERCUP SLALOM INFORMATION FOR 2011

September 17th, 2011

- WHERE: Race Site: Wolf River, near White Lake, Wisconsin – **“Boy Scout” rapids and camp**
- WHEN: Set-up, registration & trial runs Friday, September 16th 9:00 AM to ???
Saturday, September 17th registration starting at 8:30 AM, racing starting at 10:00 AM, break for lunch and conclude by 4:30 pm.
- COURSE: Number of gates will depend on water level, course will be challenging but not intimidating for most participants. Easy options as well as mentoring from experienced paddlers/instructors will be available for novice racers. **Runs on course:** We plan to allow 6 runs per paddler, but paddling tandem with a junior counts as half a run for both paddlers.
- COST / MEAL: Race Cost is \$15.00 for adults and \$10.00 for juniors. Add \$5.00 for insurance if not an ACA member.
- AWARDS MEAL: Pot Luck at 6 PM Wolf River Town Hall, south of Hwy 64 east side of Hwy 55. Bring utensils, choice of beverage. We can put food into the cooler at the Town Hall for you upon arrival Friday PM or Saturday AM. If you are unable to bring food, you are still welcome to join us – you can simply chip in a bit to help with the group costs for some community brats and hot dogs.
- Awards at 7 PM are for the race and the season series – including Cow Trophies! Door prizes to follow.
- VOLUNTEERS: We need a lot of volunteers both on Friday and Saturday to pull this event off. **Non-racers who help run the race at least ½ day will be receive a free lunch.** Please contact Scott Stalheim as soon as possible if you can help. Positions we need help with are: Safety Boaters, Starters, Scorers, Timers, Registration, Finish Line and to run the Novice Course.
- REGISTRATION: On-site. During day Friday or 8:30-9:30 AM Saturday morning. BRING YOUR ACA CARD for insurance, otherwise race day insurance is an additional \$5.00.
- ACCOMODATIONS: Check out www.wolfriverterritory.com. Also note there is a nearby U.S., Forest Service Campground. Bear Paw and Wild Wolf Inn have the closest rooms/cabins/camping to the action.
